"PETER KIEWIT SONS' CO. SATSOP PROJECT

EMPLOYEES SURPASS 1,000,000 MANHOURS

WITHOUT A DISABLING INJURY"

On May 7, 1981 Peter Kiewit Sons' Co., Mechanical-Electrical District mobilized on the Satsop project, and on July 19, 1979 began work on a very large contract for piping and equipment installation on Units 3 & 5 of a five unit nuclear complex being built by Washington Public Power Supply System. Each of the Satsop plants, located approximately 35 miles west of Olympia, Washington at the base of the Olympia Peninsula, will provide 1240 megawatts of electricity for northwest utilities.

On July 20, 1981 Kiewit employees at the Satsop project--comprised principally of Pipefitters and Weldors from Local #82 in Tacoma, Washington--surpassed 1,000,000 manhours without a disabling injury. A special ceremony was held on July 22, 1981 to commemorate the occasion, with all employees attending. Kiewit Project Manager Gordy Nordlund, along with dignitaries from the Supply System, extended their congratulations to all employees. Nordlund noted it had taken 486 calendar days to reach the 1,000,000 manhour mark and was only the fifth time in Company history it had been done. As part of the celebration a drawing was held which included awards such as an engraved fishing rod, engraved rifle, \$100 money market certificate, and last but not least, an all expense paid trip to Hawaii for two (2) for seven days. By the luck of the draw, a Pipefitter will be taking the trip to Hawaii.

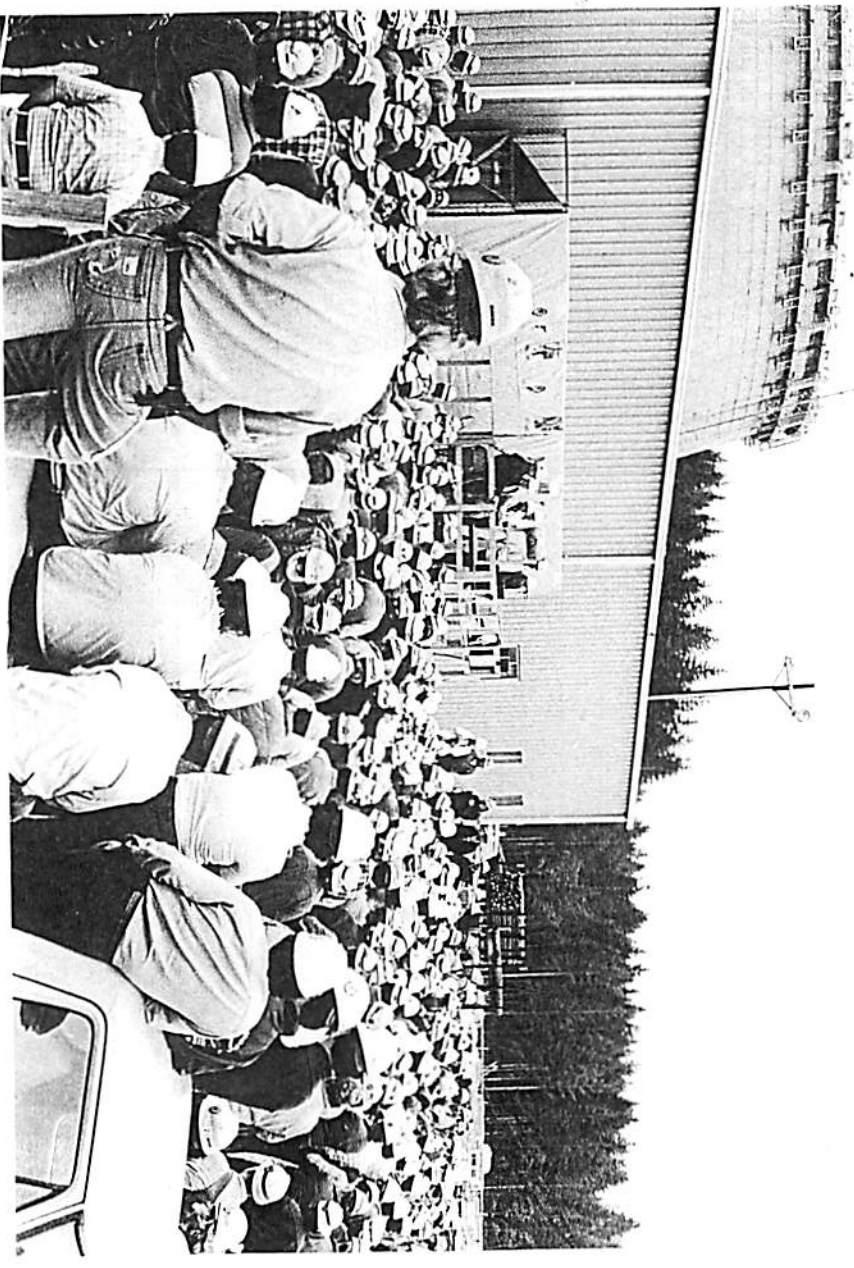

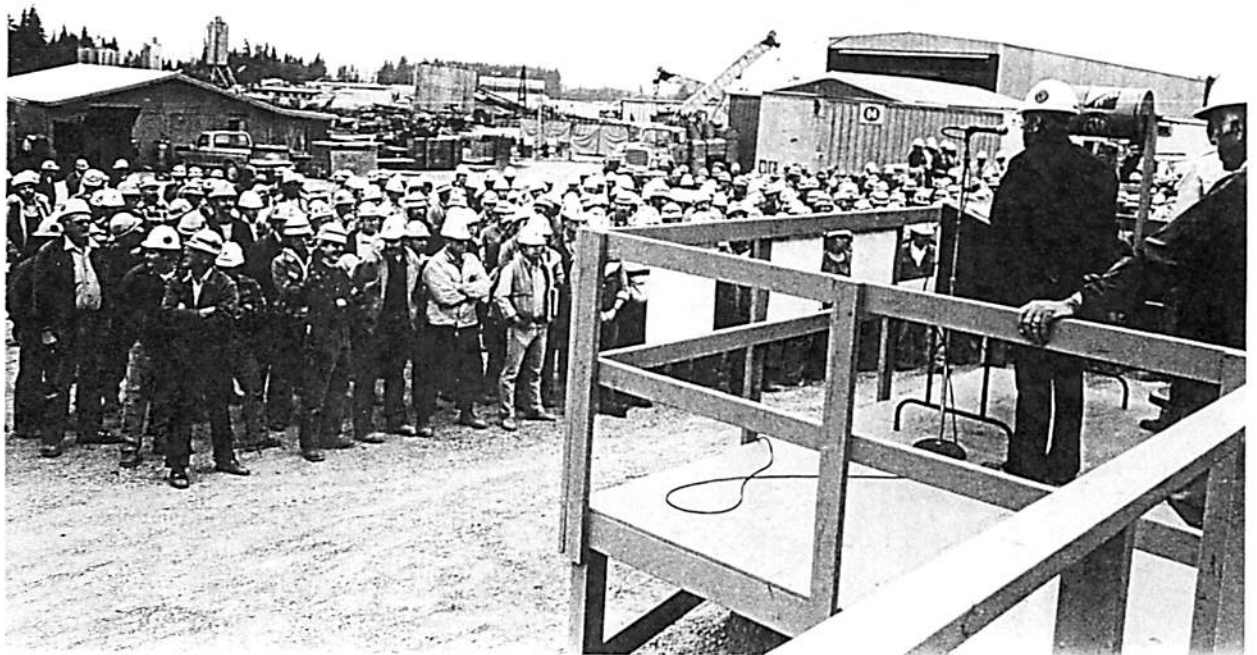
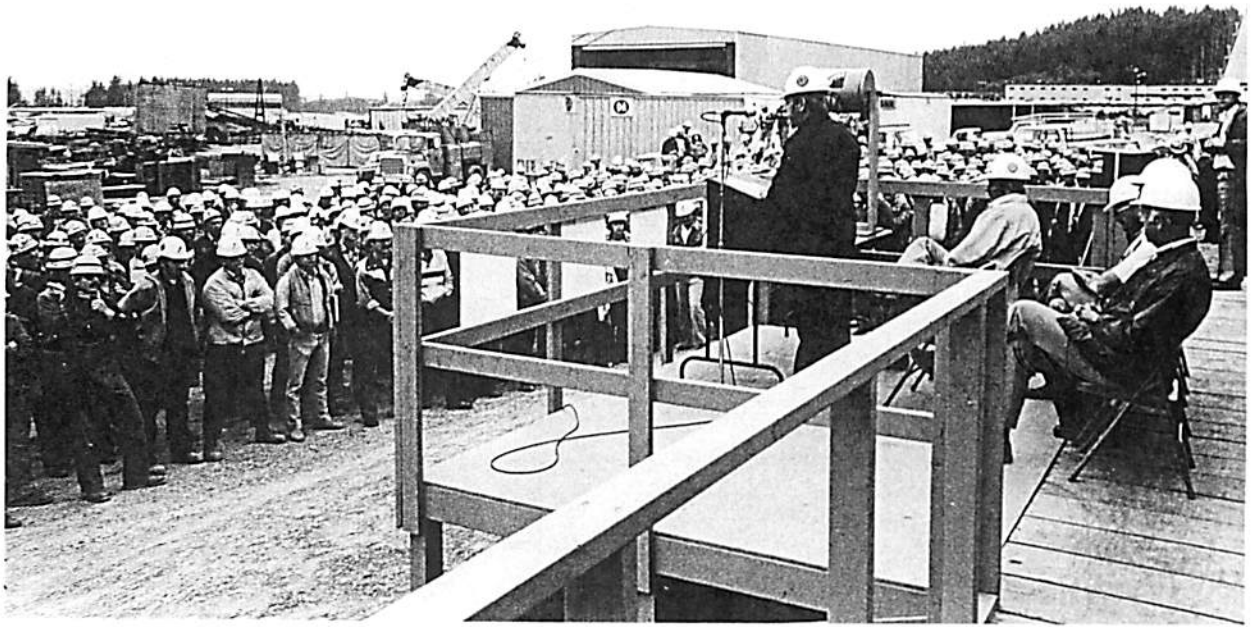
