The fall season is ushered in by a meeting with the Society of Plastics Industry. It is fitting that we have as a subject the presentation of another phase of high polymer chemistry.

We know our speaker as Assistant Professor of Chemical Engineering and as the genial, hard-working secretary-treasurer of our Section. In his spare moments he is responsible for the Utilization Division of the Pulp Mills Research Project at the University. He is also an authority on plastics. This last derives from his training and experience. Dr. McCarthy received the degree of B.S. in Chem. E. in 1934, and in 1936 was awarded the M.S. from the University of Idaho where he studied with Prof. E. C. Jahn. From there he went to McGill University to work with the late Dr. Harold Hibbert and received the Ph.D. degree in 1938. From then until 1940 he was a Lecturer at McGill and associated with the Pulp and Paper Research Institute. From 1940 until the time of his coming here in 1942 he was Director of Research with a paper company in eastern Canada.
